Each event is an individual round of the British Trials Cup 2012, points from each day counting towards the British Trials Championship title. The events will also use the scores from riders of the Scottish Biketrial Club towards their own Scottish Championship. All biketrial events will be run according to the Biketrial Federation rules as reproduced on the website www.biketrialuk.co.uk. A printed copy can be obtained from the Event Secretary if required. British Cycling will use the results from both of these events when planning UCI World event entry selection.

Both of these events are being run alongside the UCI World Cup Downhill round. The trial entry fees include a free pass for each rider, a free pass for one minder per rider, and a free pass for one parent per rider under 18 years of age. Entry passes cannot be given to late entries so be sure to meet the closing date.

FREE ENTRY PASSES:-

Please note that all riders will receive a free entry pass for the bigger event, plus one free entry pass for a minder, plus one free entry pass for a parent if under 18 years old. Please watch the website www.biketrialuk.co.uk for information on collecting the passes prior to the day.

DIRECTIONS TO THE NEVIS RANGE:-

7 miles north of Fort William off the A82 to Inverness. Post code PH33 6SW The Nevis Range is well signposted.

PARKING:-

There is no access to or parking at the venue itself. The nearest parking is at the Rural Complex (£5 charge) on the Nevis Range access road, where vehicles without passes are stopped. This is about 1km from the venue. It generally fills up by 9.30 each morning.

There is ample parking at the signposted Park & Ride car parks but bikes are not allowed on the shuttle buses. There is a cycleway from Fort William to Nevis Range (9km).

ACCOMMODATION:-

This beautiful area of Scotland is well-known as a winter skiing and snowboarding resort, and in the summer the venue for an amazing downhill biking track as well as mountain biking, and walking, complete with a gondola up the mountainside. **Why not make a holiday out of the event!** Information can be found on www.nevisrange.co.uk.
